STEPS provides a skill development and community access program which offers you choice and flexibility to suit your needs and fulfil your goals.

Each person receives one-on-one consultation with our qualified staff to assess:

- attributes and talents
- interest, experience and skills
- preferences and priorities
- support needs.

From this assessment STEPS can build an Individual Support Plan of choice to include:

Skill training

- Communication • Self esteem and confidence
- Numeracy and literacy • Healthy living
- Social interaction skills • Budgeting and work experience

Community Connection

STEPS will find the kind of places and groups or people in the community that will match to the talents and interests.

Life Experience training

Be included in community projects or work experience to build your independence and enhance vocational prospects.

STEPS program promotes a combination of one-on-one support and group support.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for STEPS Post School Services program, a young person must:

- Be 18 years of age
- Be finishing or have finished school
- Be eligible for assistance under the Disability Services Act 2006 (Qld) (visit www.disability.qld.gov.au for funding information)
- Not have access to tertiary education, vocational training or employment options
